| 1              | The total number of sections of the school shall be restricted to 14 only. School shall not increase the number of sections and any further increase in sections shall be strictly subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye law subject to availability of class rooms of greater than 500 sq ft dimension.   |
| 2              | The school compound is not properly developed and is seen with grass and shrubs. The ground should be clean and with plain surface for safely use by the students. and as per the recommended infrastructure, solid ground with permanent marking is required. No specific outdoor sports facilities are available in the ground. School should upgrade and develop the outdoor sports as per circular no 11/2022 and upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.   |
| 3              | School has not developed the out door and Indoor sports facilities and infrastructure as per recommended SoPs vide circular no 11/2022 (dated 04.10.2022). Only Kho-Kho, one volley ball court and one hand ball court are available without solid ground and permanent marking. The playground is marked with lime powder temporarily just for display. Ground should be plain with permanent marking for specific games with required infrastructure. For indoor sports school has arranged one TT and one Chess and Carom only which need to be increased with sufficient seating arrangements. The School is directed to follow the circular no 11/2022 and develop the outdoor and indoor sports facilities as per Board guidelines and SoPs and upload the compliance with YouTube link on SARAS portal within 03 months. |
| 4              | School has not arranged and provided the recommended infrastructure and facilities for the CwSN in compliance of the RPwD, Act 2016 and the Board guidelines vide circular no 05/2023. The side bars/support bars on the sides of commodes are small in size and affixed at much distance to make the toilet useful for the wheelchair bound users. School should arrange and develop the CwSN facilities and infrastructure at each floor separately for boys and girls as per the circular no 05/2023 ( <a href="https://saras.cbse.gov.in/SARAS/Circulars/Circular05_2023.pdf">https://saras.cbse.gov.in/SARAS/Circulars/Circular05_2023.pdf</a> ) and upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.   |
| 5              | The composite science lab is not developed as per board guidelines. There are cloth curtains in the window which are not safe and hazardous in science lab having chemicals and heating facility. The seating arrangement is not sufficient and the work stations are not arranged as per the recommended SoP for Labs vide circular no 11/2022. Lab has no water connection to the wash basins at present. School is directed to upgrade and develop the Composite Science Lab as per the Board guidelines with  |

|    | required infrastructure and safety standards and to upload the compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months.  |
| 6  | School building is G+1 floor but there is no ramp/lift to access the upper floor by the CwSN student. School has undertaken to construct the lift for the same. School is directed to install the lift and make compliance on SARAS portal within 03 months with YouTube video link.   |
| 7  | As reported by the RC, school is required to add more journals and collection on classics, autobiographies, biographies, travelogues, essays, fiction, poetry, drama, recreational and motivational materials as per Board guidelines. School is required to follow the SoP and circular no 11/2022 for recommended infrastructure in library for proper library operations and upload the compliance on SARAS within 03 months. |
| 8  | School has undertaken to appoint the special educator on permanent basis. The special educator and wellness teacher/instructor be appointed and compliance should be uploaded on SARAS portal within 03 months.  |
| 9  | School is required to affix permanent signage at all the prominent places in the school campus. Paper signage are affixed at toilets and other places like indoor room, drinking water facilities etc. School shall affix the permanent signage and make the compliance on saras portal within 03 months.  |
| 10 | School shall ensure the mandatory training of its teachers from the CoE, CBSE Pune within three months and shall upload the compliance on saras portal.  |

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
